The best services to provide in the room

First and foremost, it is crucial to give a **warm and friendly welcome** to the dog as well, not just the person.

Have **useful items** for the dog in the room, such as bowls or toys to keep them entertained.

Provide **odorless** items for dogs to sleep or rest on, as they are very sensitive to smells and may not sleep well if they detect a strange odor, perhaps **identifying it with another dog**.

Have a **refrigerator** in the room to store specific products the guest had to bring from home out of necessity. If it's not possible to provide a fridge in the room, offer the option to store items in a communal fridge.

Leave a blanket in the room in case the dog is used to climbing on the bed. This way, it won't easily remove the blanket, which could protect the sheets or duvet that are harder to clean.
