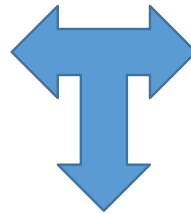

## The dual transition



In the context of the European Commission's 6 priorities, the following are 2 main axes in the “dual transition” were identified:

- 1. Green transition (or ecological transition) corresponding to priority 1 (European Green Deal);**
- 2. Digital transition corresponding to priority 2 (A Europe ready for the digital age).**



## The Green Transition (European Green Deal)



Main actions of the Green Deal to promote green (ecological) transition:

- **European climate law (for climate neutrality by 2050)**
- **European Climate Act (for the Commission's Contribution to the UN Conference (COP26) in Glasgow on climate (postponed by one year due to the Covid emergency). Held in 2021 in Glasgow Nov. 1-12 (organized by the U.K. in collaboration with Italy). Climate neutrality by 2050)**
- **Decarbonization of energy**
- **New action plan for the circular economy**
- **EU Biodiversity Strategy 2030**
- **European Green Deal investment plan**
- **Renewed strategy on sustainable finance**
- **Strategy for sustainable and smart mobility**
- **Designation of 2021 as the European Year of Railways (of sustainable transport as trains, account for only 0.5% of greenhouse gas emissions from transport in the Union)**

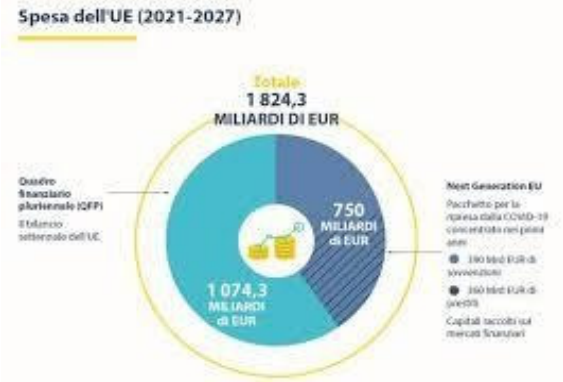


## March 2020 Covid Emergency



The Commission proposed on May 27 a strengthened EU budget to address the economic and social repercussions of the coronavirus emergency, boost sustainable recovery, and to protect jobs and create new ones and thus prevent a major economic crisis for all EU member states from flowing from the health crisis: The proposals focus on :

- **next Generation EU**, A €750 billion emergency facility to temporarily boost the financial capacity of the EU budget through funds raised on financial markets. The funds raised, channelled through EU programs, support urgently needed measures to protect livelihoods, get the economy back on track, and foster sustainable and resilient growth;
- **A strengthened multi-year financial framework for 2021-2027**, capable of rapidly targeting investment where it is most needed, strengthening the single market, intensifying cooperation in areas such as health and crisis management, and equipping the Union with a long-term budget to promote the green and digital transition and build a more equitable and resilient economy.



**NEW PROGRAMMING PERIOD 2021-2027**

Adoption of the Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) EU planning tool for resources that are allocated to European policies for a period of 7 years.

MFF resources are organized by Funds with a specific mission (such as the European Social Fund, the European Regional Development Fund and other funds, such as thematic programs).

Indirect management: structural funds

*These resources are mainly represented by the Structural Funds (ERDF-ESF) and the Cohesion Fund*

*Structural funds are not allocated directly to projects chosen by the EC; in fact, their (shared) management is the responsibility of the states and regions*

## THE OBJECTIVES OF COHESION POLICY

### Article 174 of the Treaty of the EU mentions

«to promote the harmonious development of the Union as a whole, the Union shall develop and continue its action aimed at achieving the strengthening of economic, social and territorial cohesion. In particular, the Union aims to reduce the gap between the levels of development of different regions and the backwardness of less-favored regions»

Economic cohesion policy aims to reduce development gaps between regions, decrease the backwardness of less developed areas, and enable sustainable and balanced development for all European regions (ERDF)

Social cohesion policy aims to ensure that all citizens, without discrimination of equality have access to fundamental rights in labor, social and economic matters (ESF)

Territorial cohesion policy promotes the balanced development of European territories and fosters the integration of areas with greater accessibility and growth challenges (e.g., islands, border areas, and inland areas) (ERDF through Interreg)

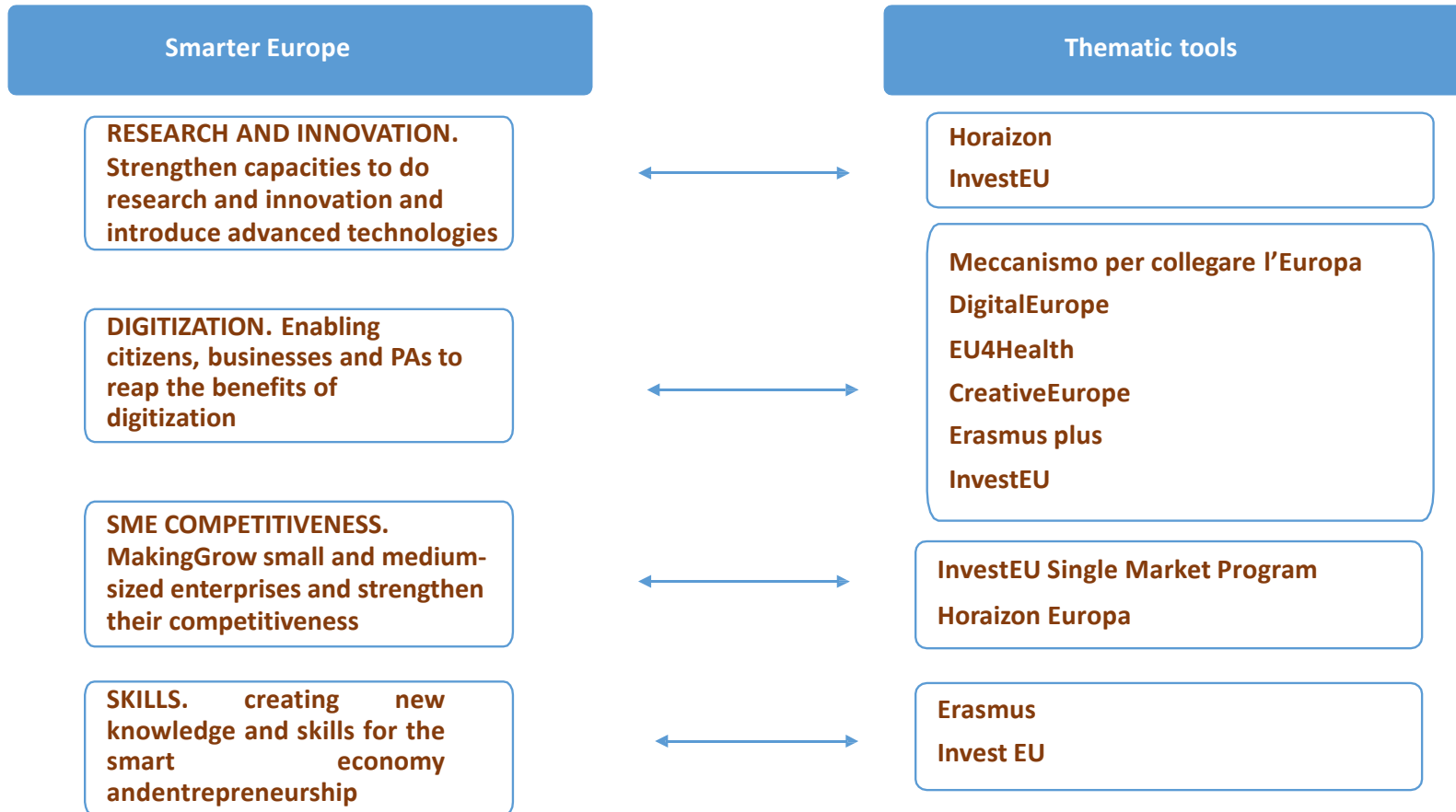

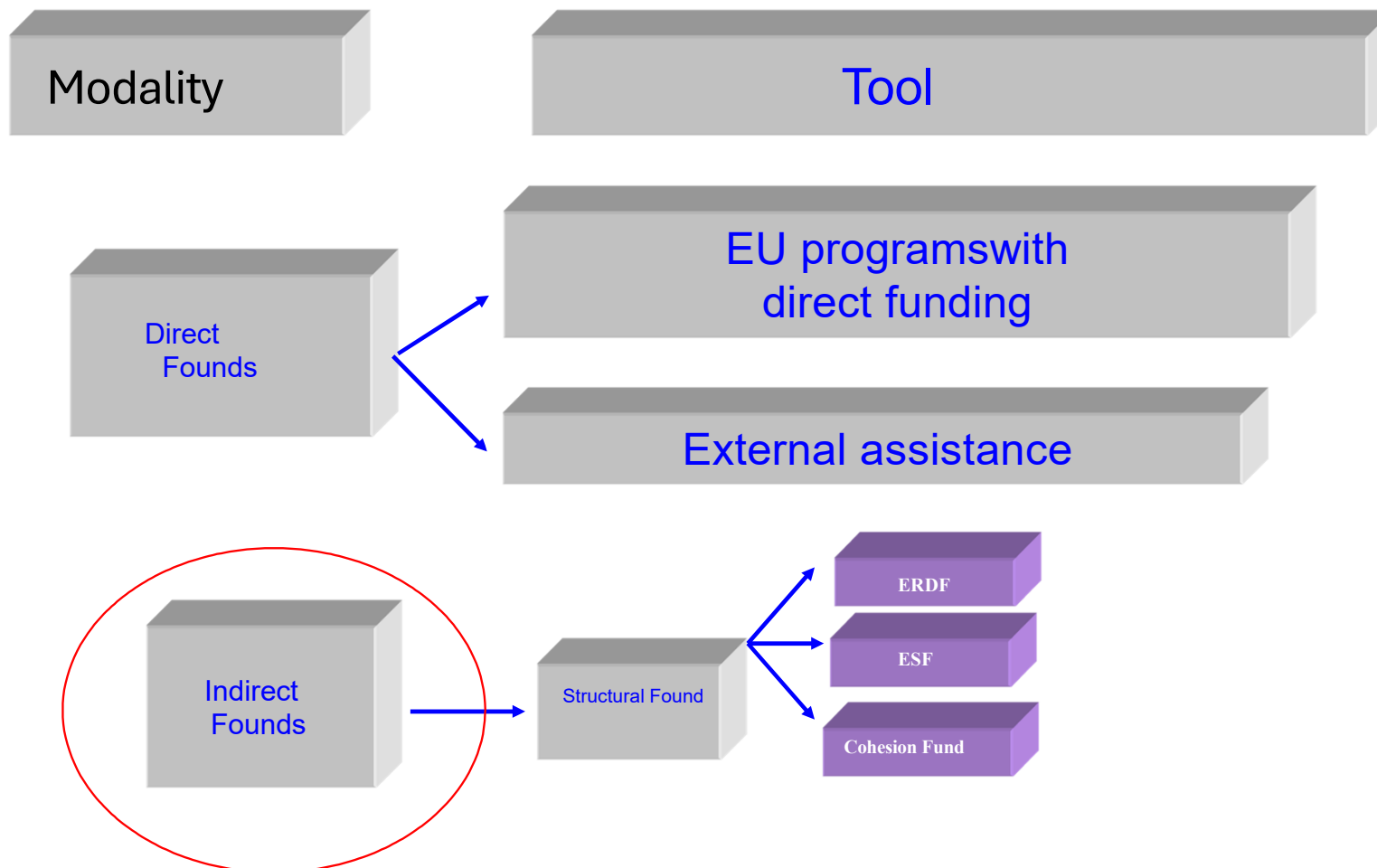

## THE TWO MAIN STRUCTURAL FUNDS

### Social cohesion

- technological innovation and scientific research
- investments in environment, energyrenewables and digital infrastructure and mobility

- environmental and cultural enhancement

## Territorial cohesion



**European territorial cooperation is implemented through three strands :**

- **Cross-border cooperation**
- **Transnational cooperation**
- **Interregional cooperation**

and helps member states overcome cross border obstacles and develop common services.



## Main innovations in territorial cohesion

### Cross-border mechanismEuropean

The European Commission has proposed a new instrument, “European Cross-Border Mechanism,” for border regions and states wishing to harmonize their legal systems

### Innovative interregional investments

Based on the success of a pilot action conducted in the 2014-2020 period, the Commission proposes to realize interregional innovative investments. Regions with equivalent “smart specialization!” resources will receive increased support for the implementation of pan-European clusters in priority areas such as:

- big data
- the circular economy
- advanced manufacturing technologies or cybersecurity

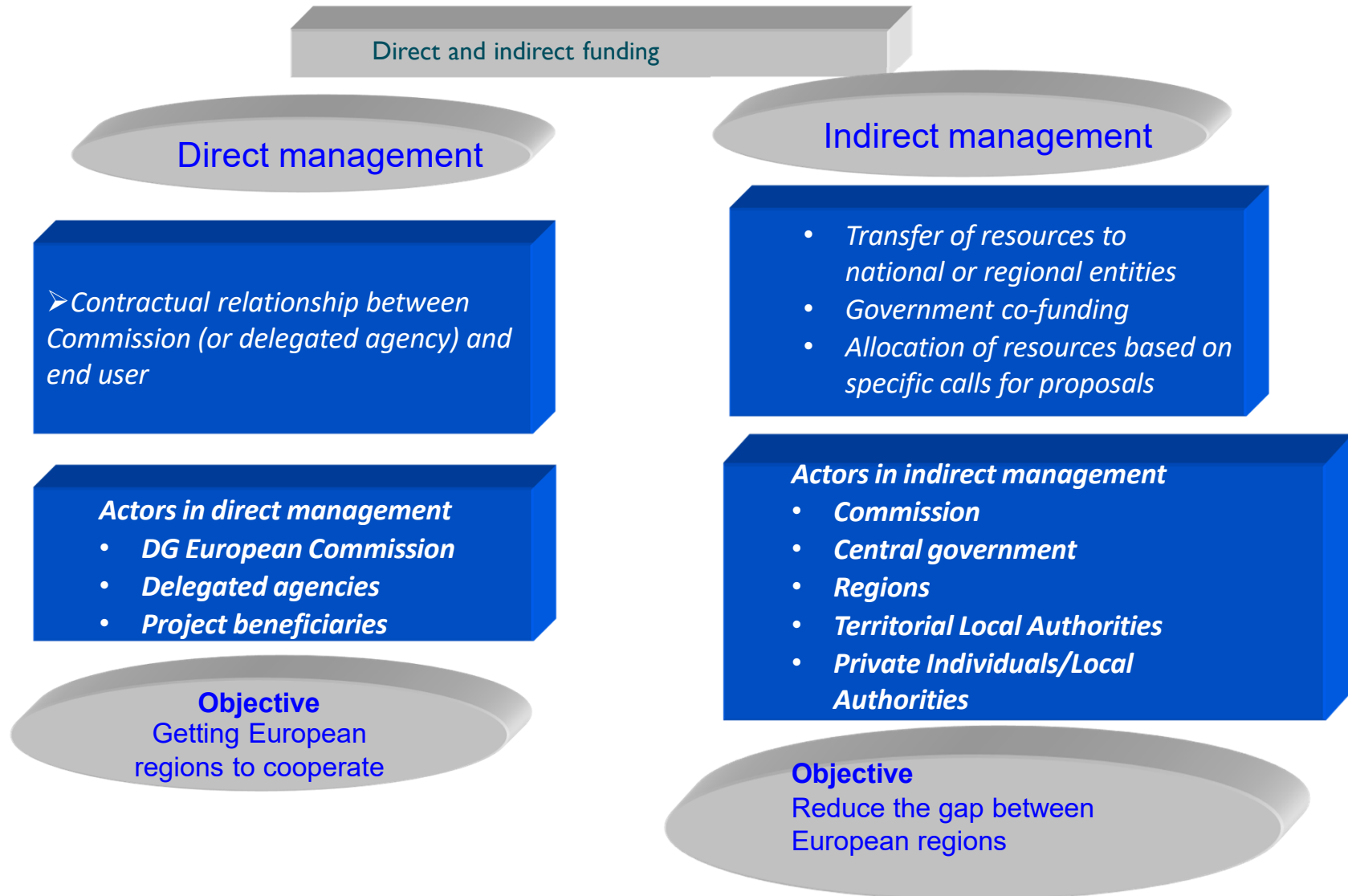

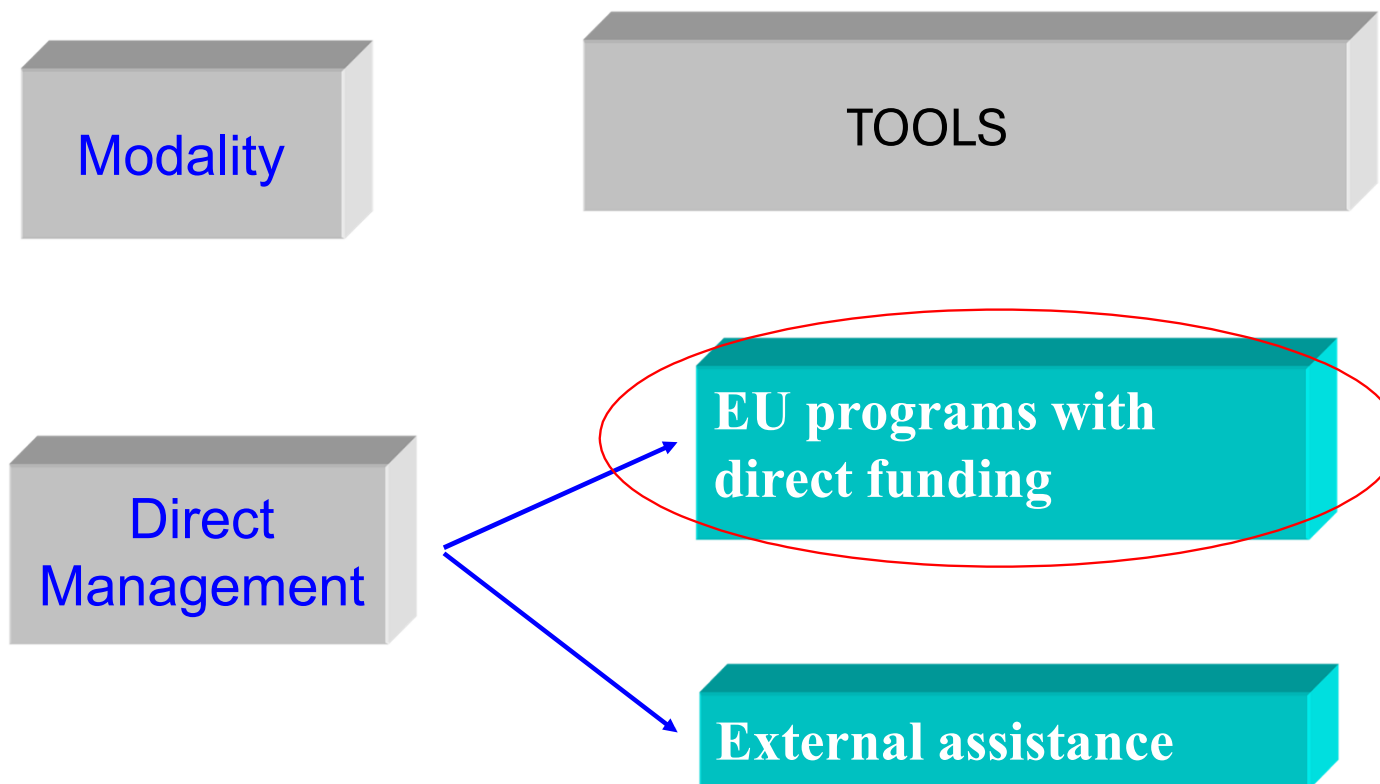

# **Direct Management: Community Programs**



“Community program” or ‘direct funding source’ may be defined as “an action, set of actions or other initiative involving expenditure which, according to the relevant basic act or budgetary authorization, is to be implemented by the Commission for the benefit of one or more categories of beneficiaries specific” (Reg. 58/2003).



*It is this **an instrument, through which the EU finances the execution of a series of actions** to achieve the objectives it has set for itself in the various matters within its competence*



*It does not provide for the implementation of works of a structural nature on a national or regional basis (a competence peculiar to structural funds), **but for the implementation of innovative projects elaborated according to the principle of partnership***

## The management of community programs



*The management of Community Programs is the responsibility of the European Commission, either through its own administrative apparatus, the DGs, or by making use, especially for administrative functions, of special executive agencies or responsible authorities.*



*There are, however, some Programs, which are implemented through the help of National Agencies constituted by the member states at the request of the Community, with the task of informing the public, collecting project proposals prepared by national operators, and finally transmitting the selected proposals to Brussels*

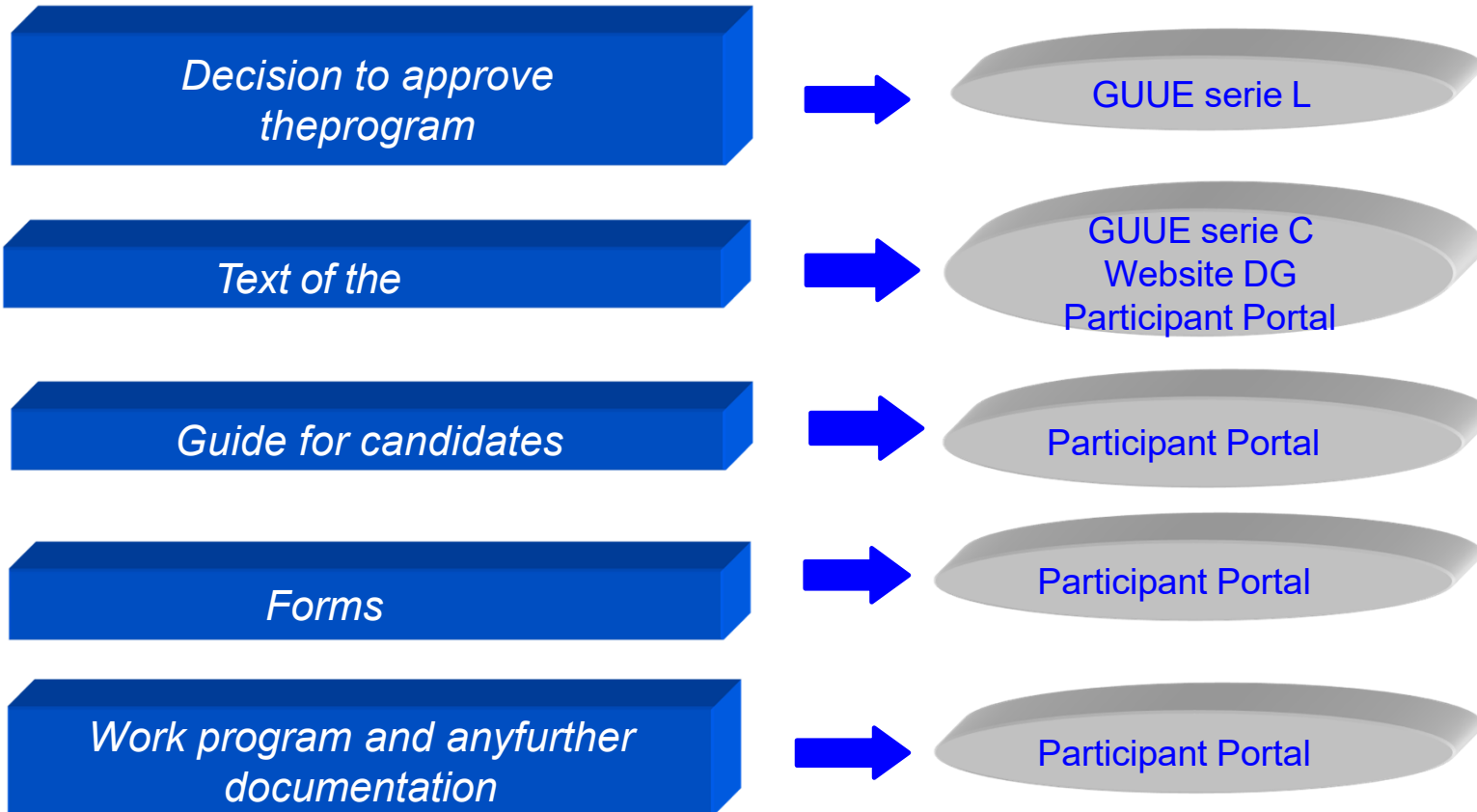

From idea to project proposal submission  
Having identified the idea, it is necessary to be equipped with the following tools



For the presentation of the proposal is important:

*Carry out an analysis of the eligible measures and their priorities stated in the call for proposals (beware of exclusion clauses)*

***sottolineare la dimensione europea, il carattere innovativo e transnazionale***

***Comply with the formal criteria for submitting the proposal***

*Prepare a summary sheet in English*

*Comply with times and deadlines stated in the announcement*

## Basic requirements:

Transnationality



*Does the project encourage mobility geography? Minimum involvement of two EU states*

Innovation



*To what extent is the project innovative? Does it create new methods and processes? Does it define new goals? Does it modify existing systems? Does it introduce new approaches?*

European added value



*the objectives and effects of the actions are better achieved at the European level than at the national or local level?*

Basic requirements:

Subsidiarity



*The EU intervenes only when local authorities, regions or the state are unable to do it themselves*

Sustainability



*The flow of benefits that the project brings must be maintained and developed in the long run. The project must be able to survive the funding*

Community interest and transparency



- Community interest: No individual initiatives are considered*
- Publication of partner data and transparency*

Communication



*For an ever closer Europe to its citizens, there will be an increasing need **to communicate the positive results of cohesion policy more effectively in 2021-2027**. Member states and regions will have to adopt stricter criteria in terms of communication, such as organizing events for the launch of major EU-funded projects and developing social media dissemination plans. Communication on EU-funded projects has been simplified through:*

- *to the adoption of a single label for all the different EU funds*
- *single portal presenting all funding available to businesses*
- *to a single project database, managed by the Commission*

## The role of the Partners: the Coordinator

Sole entity legally and financially responsible for the implementation of the project to the Commission. The coordinator is responsible for:

➤ ***manage financial operations :***

*Receives the Commission's financial contribution and ensures its distribution to each participant*

➤ ***Provide reports and status reports on the progress of the Project: in which data provided by partners are included***

➤ ***Keep up-to-date accounting records and maintain: appropriate supporting documentation relating to all expenditures, income and receipts of the project reported to the Commission***

## Financing

*Grants are always awarded on a non-repayable basis and cover percentages that on average range from 50% to 100% of the project cost (in rare cases)*

*Funding ceilings are generally stated in the calls for proposals*

The part of the budget not covered by EU support must therefore necessarily be co-funded by the project partners themselves

The project should be planned in such a way that any decrease in community contribution will not jeopardize the implementation of the entire project

# Grants

The grant is intended to meet the needs of the proposing facility and to implement the Commission's policy

*Bottom-up approach*



*Has an institutional mandate*

*Criteria*

**Quality of the proposal**

**The financial aspect matters little**

**Co-financing**

This is a non-reimbursable financial grant for partial coverage of a project. Grants are awarded through calls for proposals (calls for proposals) to co-fund a proposal/project that contributes to the implementation of a community sector policy

The Commission uses two types of grants (Grants).

## Grants awarded for specific actions

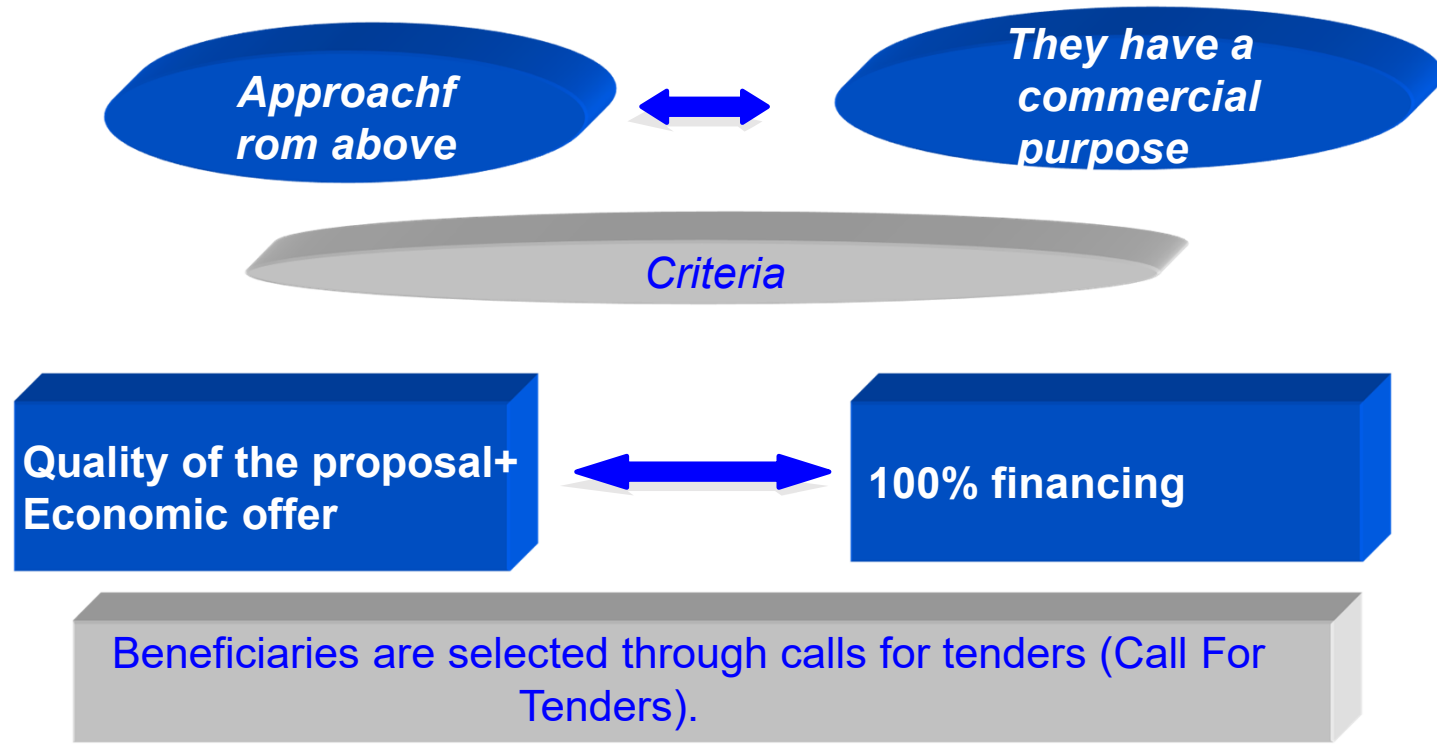
Implemented by public or private entities these are projects submitted under thematic or sectoral programs

- these projects contribute to achieving an overall objective within an EU policy

## Operating grants

- Provide financial support for the costs of the usual and permanent activities of European bodies and/or associations, generally active in the field of education and training and meeting certain criteria, particularly representativeness at the European level.
- Financial support is directly linked to the work program of the recipient organization and may include
  - personnel costs,
  - Publications
  - information and dissemination
  - travel resulting from the implementation of the work program

Tenders are intended to satisfy a specific and timely interest of the Commission. The following are not considered funding or contributions from the EU



Through competitive bidding, the Commission requires under a given community program the provision of:

**Goods**

**Work execution**

**Services**

*In the context of tenders, therefore, the Commission acts as the Principal and pays for services according to current market prices*

# Loans, SME guarantees for loans and venture capital financing

From the EU budget through various financial instruments managed by the EIB, the EU financial institution, or by the EIF, the EIB body specializing in risk capital. These types of financing are provided through financial intermediaries or local financial institutions.

# UE contributions

The funding is intended for:

- start-up
- to entrepreneurs under the age of 35
- to companies operating in disadvantaged areas that promote the creation or restructuring of entrepreneurial activities and the inclusion of the unemployed.

These contributions are usually managed indirectly by the Commission, i.e. managed by the national governments of the Member States and/or by the Regions.

Contributions are always non-repayable

# Awards

They are rewards for the winners of competitions at European level in various sectors.

For example, the Creative Europe programme awards prizes to promote and recognise sites, works, artists, organisations and cities that contribute to achieving the objectives of the cultural programme.

visto il parere del Comitato economico e sociale europeo <sup>(1)</sup>,

deliberando secondo la procedura legislativa ordinaria <sup>(2)</sup>,

considerando quanto segue:



(1) Il programma Dogana 2020, istituito ai sensi del regolamento (UE) n. 1294/2013 <sup>(3)</sup>, così come i programmi che lo hanno preceduto hanno apportato un notevole contributo all'agevolazione e al miglioramento della cooperazione doganale tra le autorità doganali, nonché allo sviluppo delle loro capacità amministrative, umane e informatiche. Dal momento che molte delle attività delle autorità doganali rivestono carattere transfrontaliero, un modo più efficace ed efficiente per sviluppare tale cooperazione consiste nell'offrire agli Stati membri un quadro entro il quale possa svolgersi istituendo un programma doganale a livello dell'Unione, attuato dalla Commissione. Inoltre, il programma Dogana 2020 si è rivelato efficiente in termini di costi e ha aggiunto un reale valore ad altri quadri di cooperazione doganale istituiti su base bilaterale o multilaterale. 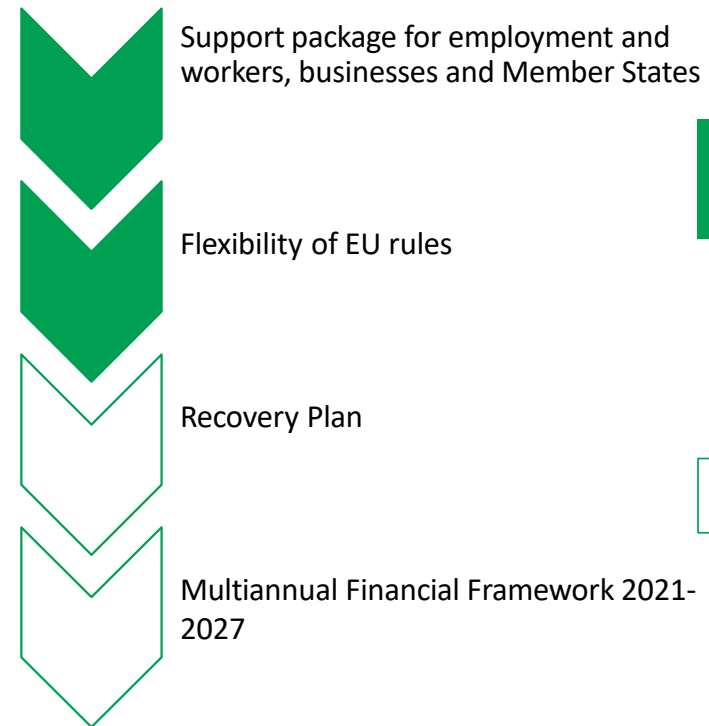

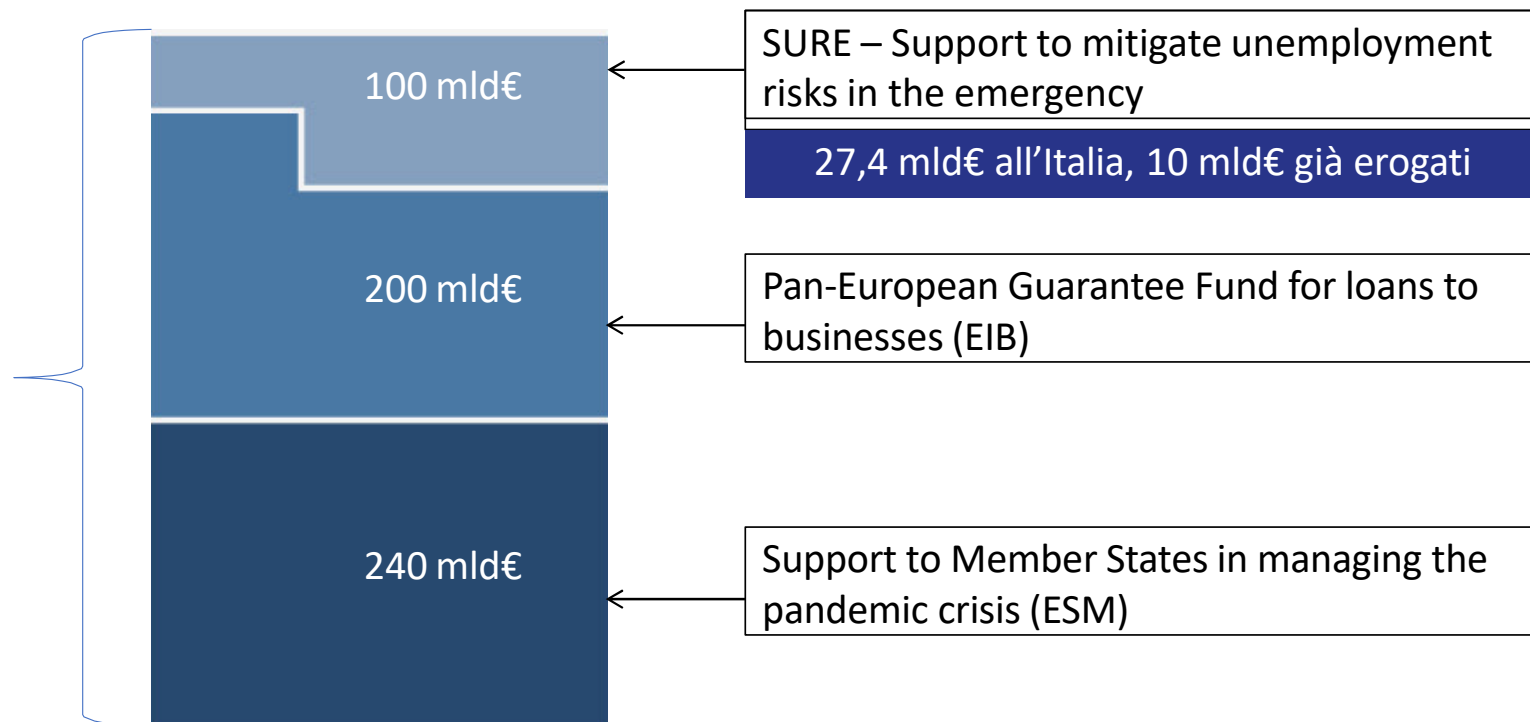

In May 2020, the Commission proposed to make available a reinforced EU budget to help repair the immediate economic and social damage caused by the coronavirus pandemic, kick-start the recovery and prepare a better future for the next generation. The tools:

- ✓ an emergency European recovery instrument "Next Generation EU" (Recovery fund) that will temporarily complement the EU budget with new financing from the financial markets;
- ✓ a reinforced multiannual financial framework for 2021-2027. The Commission proposes to create new instruments and strengthen key programmes, building on Next Generation EU, to rapidly direct investments where they are most needed.

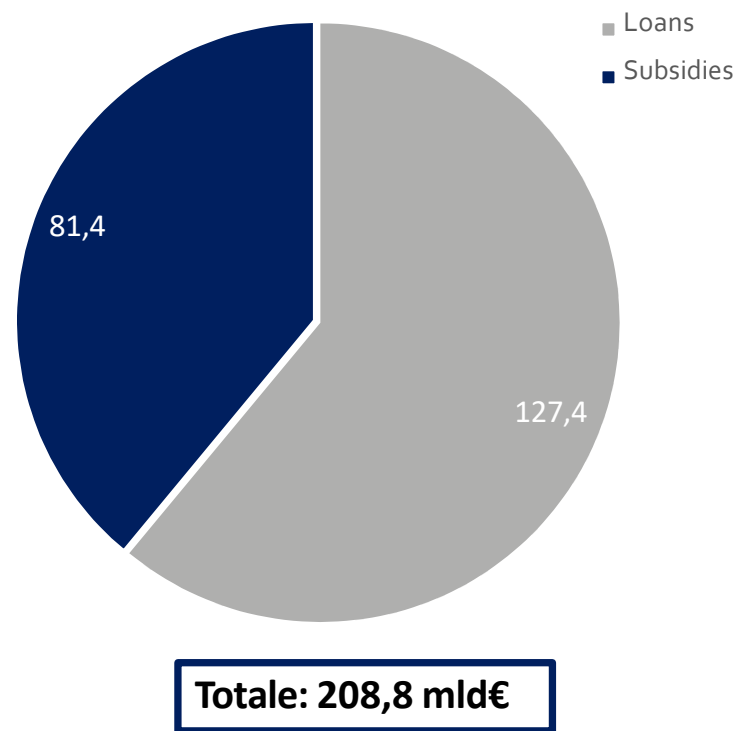

# Next Generation EU: Recovery and Resilience Facility

- (191,4 mld € per l'Italia)

- ✓ The device is NextGenerationEU's key recovery tool
- ✓ It will provide loans and grants for €672.5 billion
- ✓ To benefit from the Recovery and Resilience Facility, Member States should submit their draft Recovery and Resilience Plans, outlining their national investment and reform programmes.
- ✓ The four dimensions of environmental sustainability, productivity, equity and macroeconomic stability are the guiding principles underlying Member States' recovery and resilience plans and national reforms and investments.

# Next Generation EU: REACT-EU

## (15,2 mld € per l'Italia)

REACT-EU acts as a bridge between the current programming cycle and the next one. It will allocate additional resources to existing cohesion policy programmes, without drawing on allocations from other programmes or other resources budgeted for the coming years. The resources will be available in 2021 and 2020.

- ✓ RESOURCES AND ALLOCATION - €47.5 billion. Possibility of 100% co-financing. Criteria for MS: relative wealth, socio-economic effects of the crisis. At the discretion of the MS: ERDF, ESF, FEAD. In 2021: €11.348 billion for Italy
- ✓ PROGRAMMING - New dedicated programming in existing programs or new separate program. No ex-ante and thematic concentration. The rules of conditionality of operation will be those of the 2014-2020 period
- ✓ IMPLEMENTATION - The additional resources will support actions for a green, digital and resilient recovery: investments for the labor market, including subsidies, measures for youth unemployment, support for health systems, working capital for SMEs. Particular attention to tourism and culture, for Investments towards the green and digital transition

- Products and services for healthcare services and capital/investment support for SMEs
- Investments in the transition to a green and digital economy
- Investments in infrastructure that provide basic services for citizens and economic measures for the most affected regions/sectors

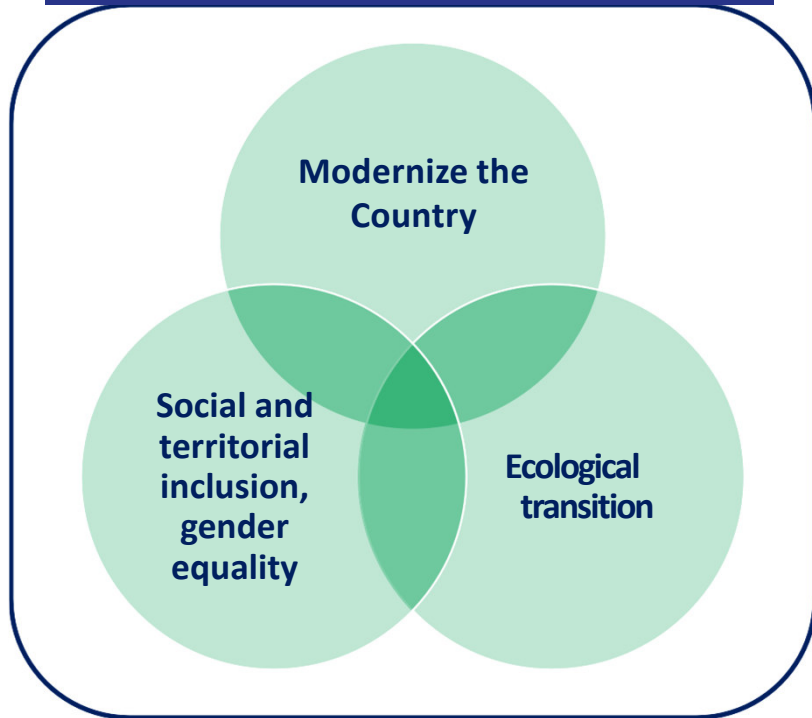

# Cohesion Policy 2021-2027

## (proposal for Italy: 43.2 billion)

- The 43.2 billion that the European Commission\* regulation proposal foresees overall for Italy (proposal to be adjusted on the basis of the outcome of the debate and the subsequent approval of the community budget): 15 billion for the ESF+, 27.5 billion for the ERDF and 780 million for European territorial cooperation
- It is not currently broken down by category of regions (more developed, less developed and in transition). Furthermore, any estimates are further complicated by the fact that at this stage the percentage incidence of the National Operational Programmes on the total resources has not yet been defined.
- In Italy, in the 2014-2020 programming period, the distribution between categories of regions saw approximately 80% of the total resources destined for our country allocated to the regions of Southern Italy and approximately 20% to the regions of Central and Northern Italy.

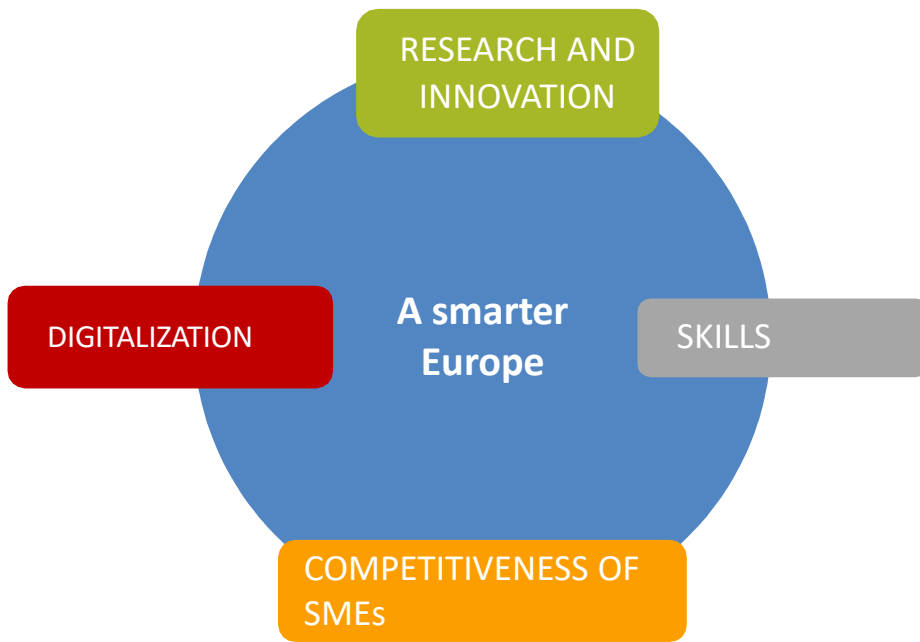

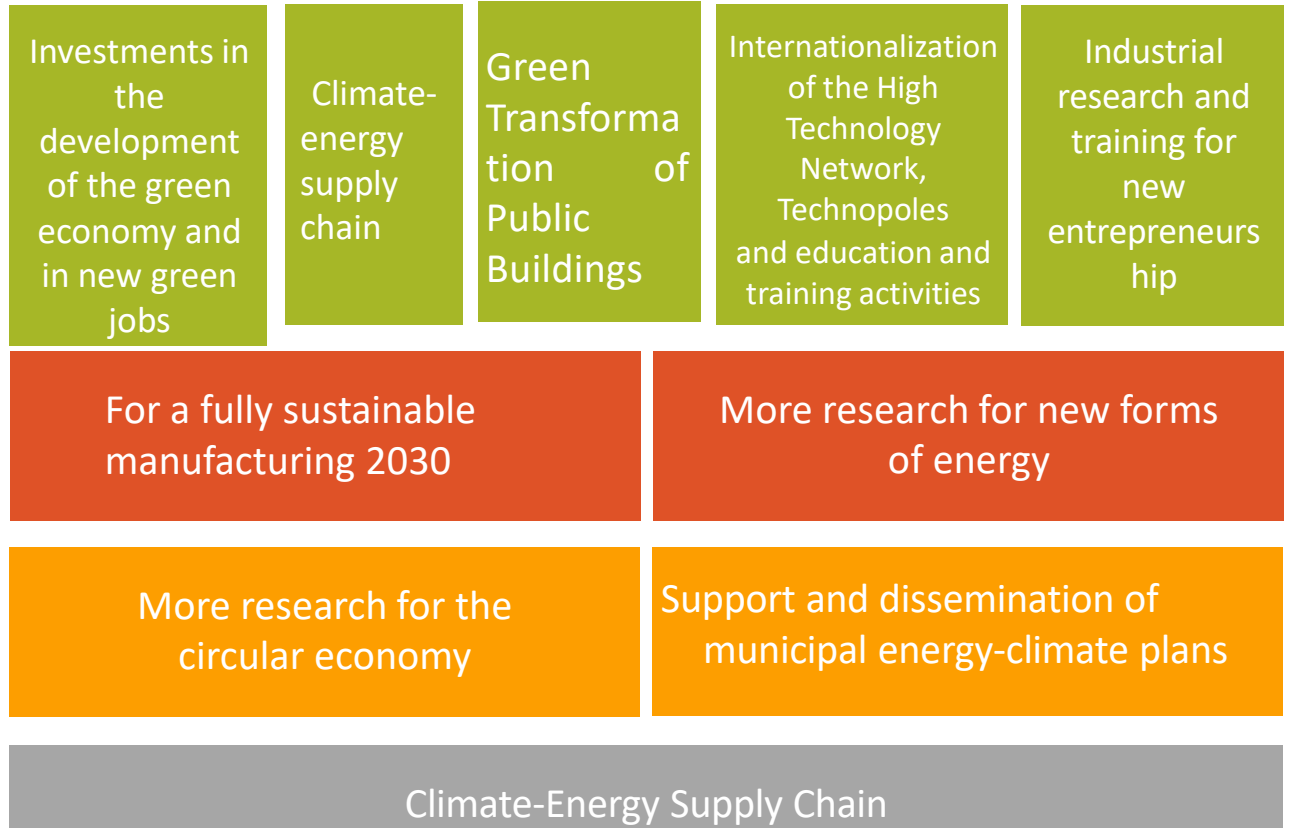
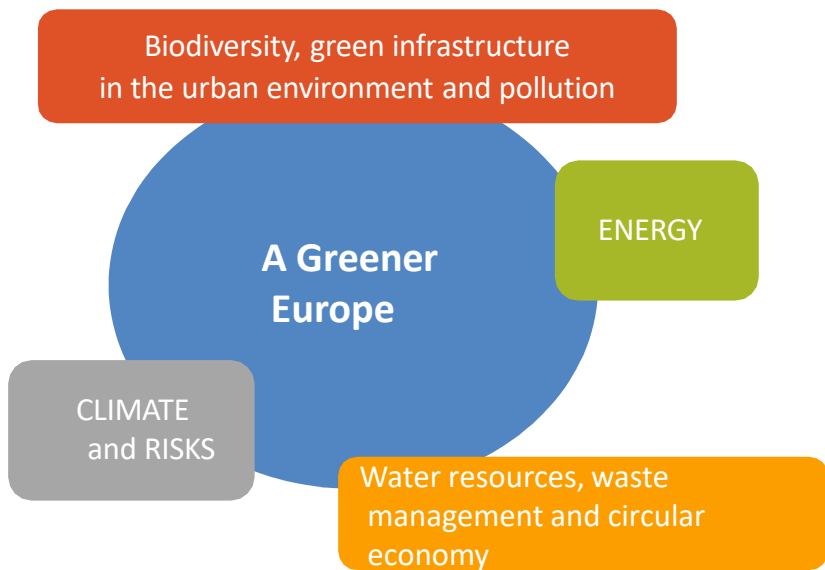
