Kick-off meeting in Rijeka

TRANSPOGOOD project is funded from the Italy-Croatia CBC programme and will develop through the capitalization of the main results of INTERMODADRIA IPA project an innovative approach towards intermodal and multimodal transport on the Adriatic sea using a complex and coherent set of tools that enable key logistics stakeholders (shippers, logistic providers, transport operators and authorities) to achieve the following main outputs:

- Innovative ICT tool (TRANSPOGOOD platform) to find the best solution of transport services (e.g., best price of combined transport, lower emissions of entire chain, eprocurement tools for maritime transport services, higher bi-directional load factor);
- Profile calculator solutions to monitor logistics and environmental performances demonstrating concrete benefits in transport and logistics implementations, involving cargo flows and operational processes from the point of view of public authorities, e.g., port authorities, and private intermodal transport operators;
- Guidelines and requirements for migrating to the TRANSPOGOOD platform from current systems and architectures, shared and consistent with the capitalised INTERMODADRIA project and with the past initiatives carried out on European level with which TRANSPOGOOD project creates important synergies.



Expected results of the project contribute to improve the quality, safety and environmental sustainability of marine and coastal transport by means of multimodal approaches in the Programme area by promoting multimodality and an increase of more sustainable modes of transport.
