## Local event - Rijeka

On 16.05.2018 KIP, Lead partner of the TRANSPOGOOD project participated in the 5th Career Day of the Faculty of Maritime Studies in Rijeka. On this occasion, TRANSPOGOOD project was presented to students, professors and other exhibitors.

Numerous students and guests passed through the lecture halls and corridors during this event to meet with more than 75 exhibitors who presented their activities to them, and many expressed interest in hiring new employees.

Career Day was officially opened by the Head of the Administrative Department for Maritime Affairs, Transport and Communications, Ms. Nada Milošević, expressing sincere enthusiasm for the size of the event. Dean of the Faculty, Associate Professor dr. sc. Alen Jugović pointed out the goal of the Career Day: recognizing students in the labor market by introducing businessmen and institutions to the study programs of the Faculty, but also presenting businessmen, their activities and expressing the need for work.

During the day, presentations of companies were held in lecture room 207, where students could ask questions and learn many important information for future careers. This event goes a step further than regular education, current students are introduced to employers, and graduate students are "returning" to the Faculty. KIP used this opportunity to present their work, and especially the TRANSPOGOOD project which focuses on logistics, and will offer the opportunity to attend webinars about the jobs in this field.
