1. "Environment and circular economy" - Scienza in Villa

Project partner **ARPAV** carried out a lecture titled "Environment and circular economy" - Scienza in Villa on **3 October 2025**, aimed at secondary school students, with **30 participants** in attendance. ARPAV was invited to the **Scienza in Villa event in Montebelluna** to present topics related to the environment and the circular economy to middle school classes participating in the event. The Wastereduce project was also introduced, highlighting the importance of proper waste management and the recovery of waste from various environmental sources.

3. Etra Academy's Progetto Scuole - "Don't Abandon Me" through school year 2024-2025 and 2025-2026

Project partner **ETRA** carried out a lecture designed for primary, secondary, and high school students, reaching a total of **2,550 participants** across all Etra municipalities. The lessons aim to raise awareness about plastics, including their composition, types, the role of packaging, recycling processes, and the fate of “other” plastics that are not easily recyclable. They also addressed the environmental impact of plastic pollution, particularly its effects on ecosystems when improperly discarded, as well as the risk of plastics entering the food chain through the sea, including the Mediterranean. In addition, the programme explored alternative solutions to reduce plastic overuse and empower individuals to make a positive impact by adopting “plastic-free” lifestyles wherever possible.
