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MILEPORT: A look back at the progress achieved so far

>>> More than two years after its launch, the **MILEPORT** project has entered a key implementation phase. Project partners are now actively working on the deployment of the pilot actions that will test innovative ICT solutions for improving last-mile accessibility in Adriatic ports.

- ➔ Before focusing on the implementation phase, however, we would like to take a moment to look back at the work carried out so far and the main achievements that have laid the foundations for the pilots.
- ➔ Over the past months, **partners have worked closely together** to develop common strategies, action plans and technical solutions, while engaging stakeholders and strengthening cross-border cooperation.



PROGRESS SO FAR>>>

Since the beginning of the project, partners have worked closely together to deliver key strategic and operational outputs.

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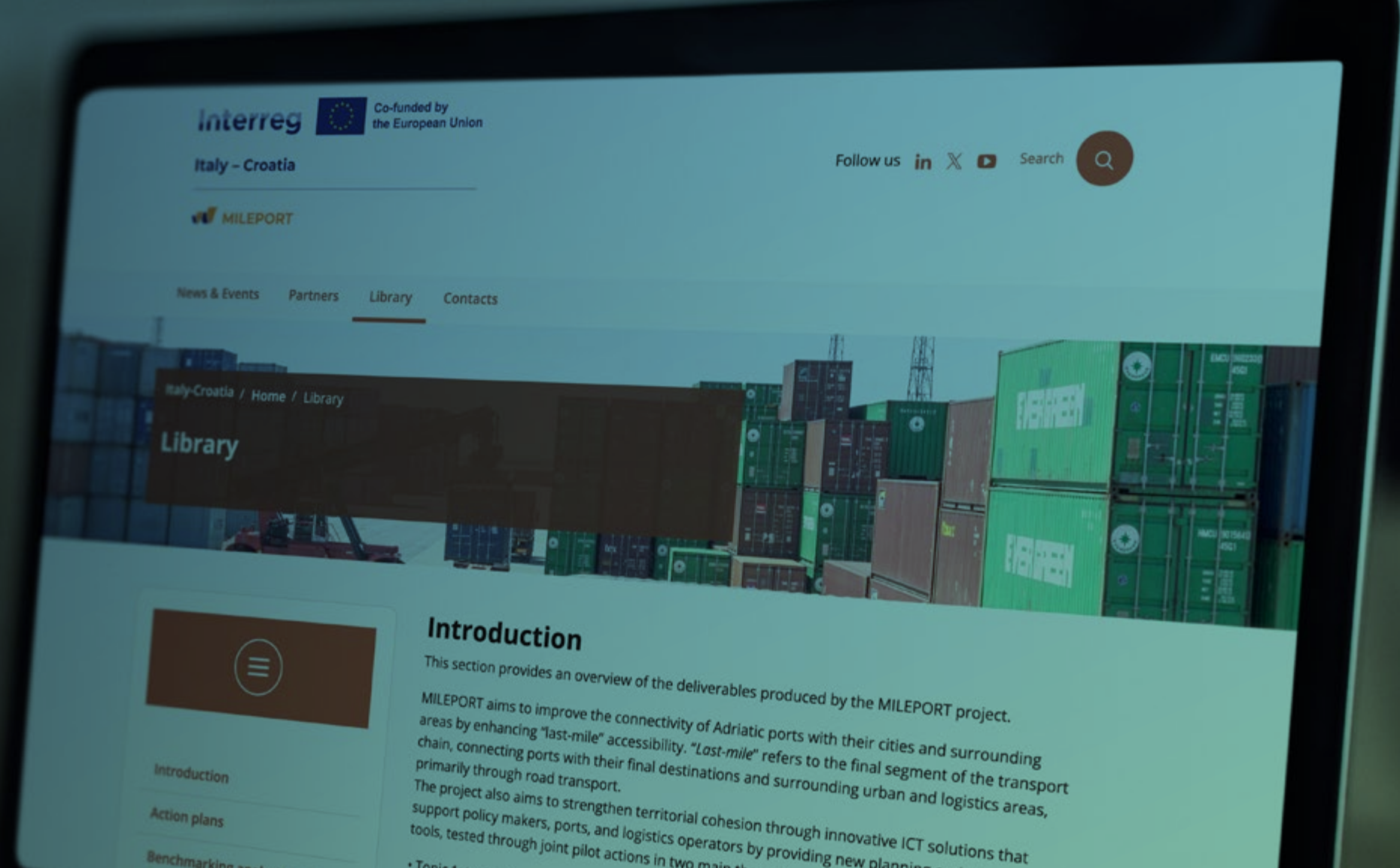
The initial phase focused on the development of a joint cross-border strategy, supported by the exchange of experiences, the identification of common stakeholder groups and the definition of shared Key Performance Indicators (KPIs).



Building on these foundations, partners engaged with local stakeholders **to identify operational needs and jointly prepared two action plans** addressing traffic flow management and vehicle booking systems, as well as gate entry and exit procedures. These plans define activities, timelines, resources and KPIs, providing a common roadmap for implementation across the partnership.



The project **has now entered its operational phase, with pilot actions being prepared and launched at the participating ports.** Continuous collaboration and mutual learning have supported the definition of technical solutions, procurement activities and the monitoring of implementation progress through dedicated status reports.

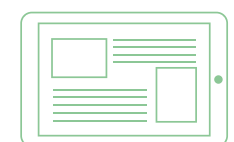
