CYROS panel discussion held on Weekend outdoor festival in Fažana

How can we connect cycling routes with public transport, improve road safety and make Istria an even stronger cycle tourism destination? These topics were at the heart of a panel discussion held at the Weekend Outdoor Festival in Fažana, within the CYROS project organised by Istria region. The Adriatic-Ionian Cycling Route, largely following EuroVelo 8, aims to offer a safe, sustainable and experience-rich trail, boosting connectivity across Istria and beyond. Experts in transport, infrastructure and tourism highlighted the importance of:



- Better integration of cycling and public transport
- Stronger road safety measures
- Early expert involvement and quality project documentation
- Digital tools and mobile apps for easier, safer and more enjoyable cycling experiences

With its ideal terrain and rich outdoor attractions, Istria continues to position itself as a top destination for cyclists, visitors and locals alike.

Bike&Bus: Free service from Trieste to Poreč -every weekend from June 7 to November 2, 2025

From June 7 to November 2, 2025, every weekend cyclists will be able to travel easily between Trieste and Poreč thanks to the new free Bike&Bus service. The bus departs from Trieste Bus Station at 14:00 and returns from Poreč at 18:00, with optional stops in Rabuiese and Plovanija. Reservations are required via the “Tratte Speciali in Bus” platform. This pilot initiative is implemented within the CYROS project, co-financed by the Interreg Italy–Croatia Programme, promoting sustainable and intermodal mobility across the Adriatic-Ionian region.

**Ready for CYROS study visits on bike in autumn?****Emilia - Romagna region**

The Institute for Transport and Logistics Foundation, CYROS project partner, in collaboration with the Emilia-Romagna Region, planned the first Cyros Cycling Relay through the regional Adriatic cycle path on **24th and 25th September 2025**. The plan is to cycle from Chioggia to Pesaro to map existing infrastructures and services, and to better inform local and regional stakeholders on the importance of promoting cycle mobility and cycle tourism. Istria region

The Region of Istria will organise a guided bicycle tour along the Parenzana trail and the Adriatic-Ionian route on **October 17, 2025**, starting from the Parenzana rest point in Poreč-Parenzo. The aim is to promote the route and provide local and regional stakeholders with better insight into the importance of supporting cycling mobility and tourism. Join us on National cycling conference in Istria October 15 - 17, 2025

The National Cycling Conference is a project of the Ministry of the Sea, Transport and Infrastructure of the Republic of Croatia. It provides relevant stakeholders in cycling development with a platform to exchange knowledge and experiences, present achievements, establish contacts, and foster cooperation.

The conference was first launched in 2022 as a pilot activity of the EU project Danube Cycle Plans, attracting significant attention from both experts and the wider public. Encouraged by this success, the Ministry decided to turn the National Cycling Conference into a regular annual professional event dedicated to cycling mobility.

The fourth edition of the National Cycling Conference will be held in Poreč, from 15 to 17 October 2025 where CYROS project will be presented.
