

the green and digital transition.








#### **RELEVANCE of OBJECTIVE 1**

To reduce the negative impact on the environment and to increase the resistance to climate changes of the cross-border transport system including improvements in alternative energy production and energy savings capacities










#### **RELEVANCE of OBJECTIVE 2**

To develop the cross-border transport by improving or introducing ICT systems including also systems that are strengthening the physical and/or cyber security in ports





community in the entire crossborder region (TEN-T and nonTEN-T ports).







