	<p>The personal data processed consist exclusively of the relevant email contact(s) directly linked to the project outputs. The data collected may also be processed for archiving purposes (registration and document retention) and, in aggregated form, for statistical purposes.</p>
	<p>Legal basis for processing (pursuant to Article 6(1)(e) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 – performance of a task carried out in the public interest) in the framework of the Programme’s institutional activities, including the preparation and implementation of capitalisation initiatives (such as the upcoming 4th Call for proposals).</p>

	<p>The data will not be transferred to a country outside the European Economic Area.</p>
	<p>The data is not subject to any automated decision-making process.</p>
	<p>The data storage period, pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 1, letter e) of Regulation 2016/679/EU, is determined for archiving purposes (registration and document storage), the time established by the internal rules of the regional administration and by relevant laws and regulations.</p>
