PURPOSE, LEGAL BASIS AND PROVISION OF DATA	
	Your data have been gathered by the Programme Managing Authority (MA)/Joint Secretariat (JS) for the purposes relating to the organisation and the management of the event “Stories Across Borders How audiovisual communication enhances territorial cooperation” Your mailing details may also be used for information strictly related to the Programme and its implementation.
	Data are processed exclusively for the length of time necessary to achieve the objectives for which they were collected and will be kept for archiving purposes (protocol and document preservation), for the time established by the internal rules specific to the regional administration and by relevant laws and regulations.
	Legal basis for processing (pursuant to Articles 6 of Regulation 2016/679/EU): Article 6(1)(e) concerning the performance of a task carried out in the public interest.



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	The provision of data is optional, but some data is marked as “required”. Failure to provide the data marked as “required” will make it impossible to participate in the event.
METHODS OF PROCESSING, SCOPE OF KNOWLEDGE AND RETENTION PERIOD	
	The processing of your personal data shall be carried out with computerized and manual methods. The data, processed by authorized persons, may be disclosed to: competent Authorities for the control, regional personnel responsible for managing the service execution phase. During the event, photographs and audio-visual footage will be taken. That material will be solely used for the communication of the Programme Interreg Italy-Croatia.
	The data will not be transferred to a country outside the European Economic Area.
	The data is not subject to any automated decision-making process.
	The data storage period, pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 1, letter e) of Regulation 2016/679/EU, is determined for archiving purposes (registration and document storage), the time established by the internal rules of the regional administration and by relevant laws and regulations.
RIGHTS AND SUPERVISORY AUTHORITIES	
You are entitled to the rights provided for in Regulation 2016/679/EU and, in particular, you may ask to Head of the Managing Authority of the Interreg Italy-Croatia Programme for access to your personal data, rectification, integration or, where applicable, erasure or restriction of processing, or object to their processing.
