DESCRIPTION

The BIOPRESSADRIA project will develop a cross-border strategy to mitigate the impact of tourism on marine and coastal biodiversity, with innovative solutions applied to coastal management.

The project is funded by the Interreg Italy-Croatia Programme under priority “P2: Green and resilient shared environment”. The Lead Partner is the Municipality of Monfalcone.

Cross-border cooperation in this project will enable the sharing of experiences, data, and information among project partners and stakeholders, thereby further contributing to increasing the efficiency of protecting valuable marine habitats.

THE VALUE OF SEAGRASS

Seagrass is one of the most valuable habitats and provides multiple benefits for the environment, including biodiversity refuge, carbon storage and prevention of coastal erosion.

However, anchoring on seagrass can significantly damage seagrass meadows, thereby altering the marine and coastal ecosystem.

OUR CONTRIBUTION

BIOPRESSADRIA aims to put forward a strategy to mitigate the impact of nautical tourism on biodiversity, with improved mooring and marine spatial planning.

A toolbox of solutions will be tested in 5 pilot areas: Panzano Bay, Kornati National Park, Pakleni islands, Badija and the islands around Korčula and the MPA Porto Cesareo.
