By registering, participants expressly consent, pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679, to the processing of their personal data and, where applicable, special categories of personal data — including their possible communication or dissemination to project partners, the Lead Partner, and the Managing Authority of the programme — strictly within the purposes described in the Privacy Notice.

Such data may be shared with third parties under agreements with the University and in accordance with the terms of the project and the Regulation ([link to the Regulation](#)), for the proper execution of the event and/or initiative, without affecting the dignity, honour, decency, or personal safety of the data subject.

Processing of Personal Data

The University of Trieste, as Data Controller, informs you about how your personal data are processed through video recordings and images taken following your voluntary participation in events and initiatives. Subject to the acquisition of your explicit consent, the images and/or videos may be disseminated through the aforementioned University communication channels and shared with third parties under agreements with the University, for the proper execution of the event and/or initiative.

Legal Basis and Purpose of the Processing

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data, as described above, is your consent, which may be withdrawn at any time pursuant to Articles 6 and 7 of EU Regulation 2016/679, Article 10 of the Italian Civil Code, and Articles 96 and 97 of Law 633/1941 on Copyright.

This specific data processing is carried out for cultural, social, and promotional purposes related to events and initiatives organised by the Data Controller.

Data Controller

The Data Controller for the processing of personal data is the University of Trieste, located at Piazzale Europa, 1 – 34127 – Trieste, Italy.

Data Protection Officer

The Data Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO), in accordance with Article 37 of EU Regulation 2016/679, who can be contacted at: dpo@units.it.

Methods of Processing

Personal data will be processed in both paper and electronic formats, in compliance with the principles set out in Article 5 of EU Regulation 2016/679—such as non-excessiveness, relevance, minimisation, and accuracy—by individuals specifically authorised to carry out the processing, and by adopting appropriate technical and organisational measures pursuant to Articles 28, 29, and 32 of the Regulation.

Data Transfer

The images collected for the purposes described above may be disseminated through publication on the following channels: YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, the University's institutional website, and may also be shared with third parties under agreements or conventions with the University for the proper execution of the event and/or initiative.

The University is responsible for managing the material published exclusively on its institutional website and official institutional social media profiles.

Retention Period

In compliance with Article 5 of the Regulation, the Data Controller retains image and video recordings for a period of 2 years, after which the materials are removed from social media channels, the institutional website, and any other platform, and subsequently destroyed.

Providing the personal data covered by this notice is necessary for the dissemination of your image and/or video. Refusal to provide such data may make it impossible to proceed with the communication and/or dissemination described above.

Rights of the Data Subject and How to Exercise Them

You may exercise your rights under Articles 15–22 of the Regulation—namely, the right to access your personal data, request their rectification if inaccurate, their completion if incomplete, and, in the cases provided by law, request restriction, erasure, or object to their processing—by sending a specific request to the Data Controller at site@dia.units.it, or to the Data Protection Officer at dpo@units.it.

If you believe that your data have been processed in a manner that does not comply with current legislation, you may lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority pursuant to Article 77 of the Regulation, or file a judicial appeal with the competent authority.
